

## How to setup Nursing Rehab Minutes

Go to: Setting > POC > Nursing Rehab > Options, and make sure the highlighted option is checked and Saved.

Then, click on the ‘Resident Schedule’ – see example below

- Select an Assignment – 2-4 morning
- Select a resident – Test Testone
- Fill in the minutes for the day/s per **Nursing Rehab items** – example, Bed Mobility, Friday 20 min
- Click on **Save**
