MED e-care
Your Care, Our Mission

Nourish is the system of record for <u>resident</u> details.

The following data flows **FROM Nourish TO MED e-care**:

- Title
- First name
- Last name
- Gender
- DOB
- NHS number
- Photo
- Admitted/discharged status
- Date of admission
- Date of discharge (if applicable)
- Allergies and intolerances
- Address (room number, if set up in Nourish)
- For data to flow, the resident must
 - be marked as "permanent" and "residential" in Nourish
 - have an NHS number and date of birth correctly entered with no spaces or special characters





MED e- care and Nourish - Resident & Medication API

MED e-care is the system of record for <u>medication</u> details.

The following data flows **FROM MED e-care TO Nourish**:

Administration Details:

- Medication name
- "Administered" or "Not Administered"
- Reason for "Not Administered", if applicable
- Amount given
- Any notes
- Staff name
- Witness name, if applicable

Medication Profile Details:

- Medication name
- Start date and end date if applicable
- Instructions
- Status:
 - Active
 - Discontinued (with dates)
 - On Hold (with dates)



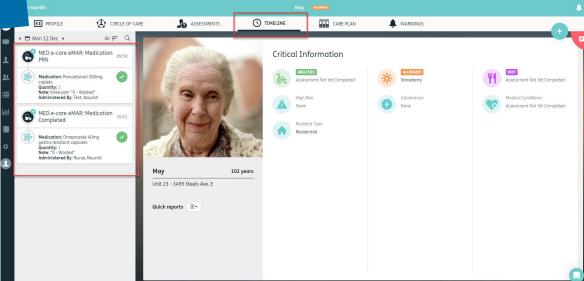


Data Flow Examples



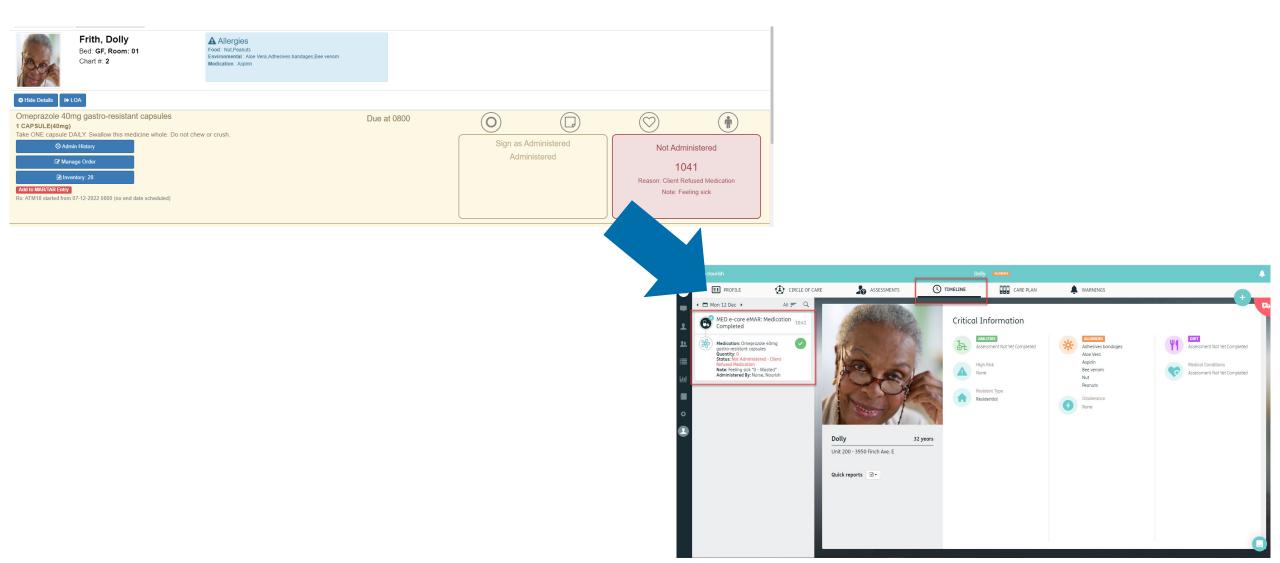






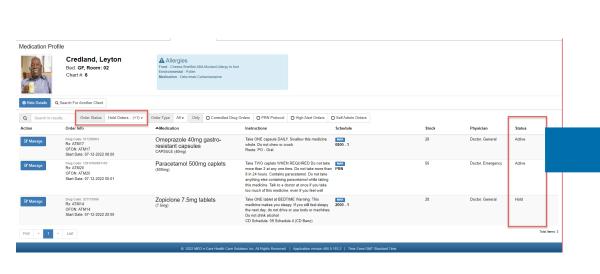


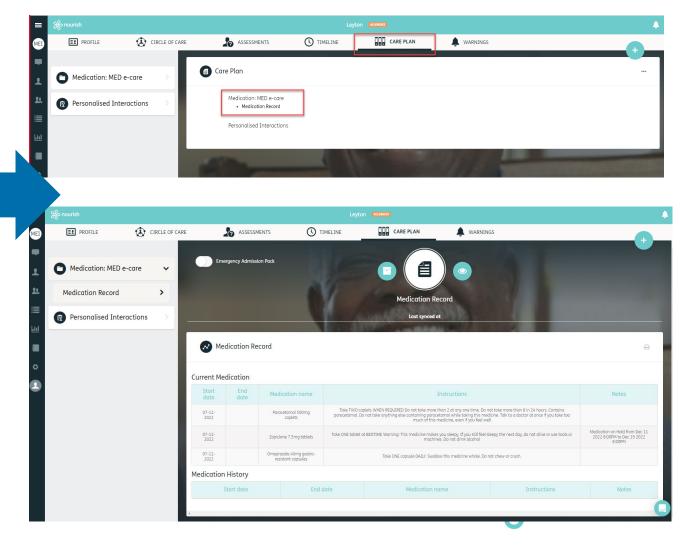
"Not Administered" in MED e-care





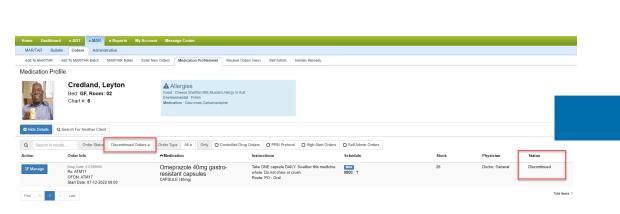
Medication Profile – Active and On Hold Meds (Current Medication)

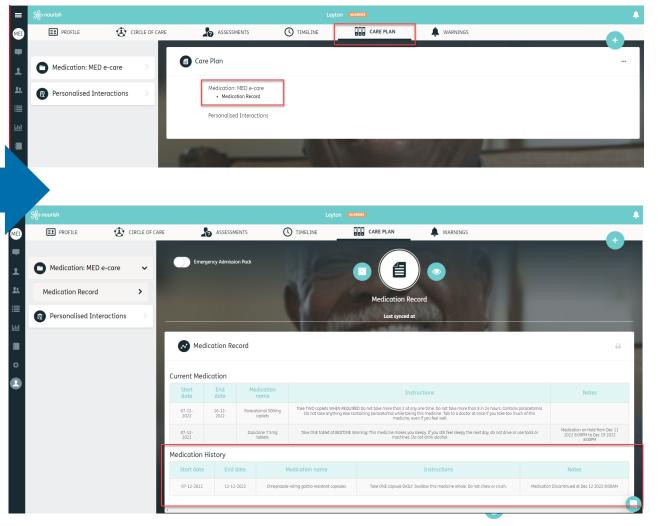






Medication Profile – Discontinued / Ended (Medication History)








Activating The Integration



- 1. Complete the <u>Pre-Integration Checklist</u>
- 2. In Nourish, head over to *Extensions* located under Administration in the menu and navigate to MED e-care eMAR.
- 3. Select the warning icon for your service to view NHS numbers & Date of Birth for your residents. Please ensure that each individual has a valid NHS/CHI number (no white spaces) and DOB in Nourish. If there is missing/incorrect information, please update the profiles before you progress.






4. MED e-care will share with you a token to enable the integration.

5. Head back over to *Extensions* in Nourish and locate *MED e-care eMAR* in the list. Toggle on the integration on for your service(s).





6. Read and accept the T&Cs.



- 7. Enter the token(s). We recommend that you copy and paste the token(s) to ensure accuracy.
- 8. Let MED e-care know this has been done.
- 9. A matching exercise is now required to ensure that your residents match on both sides of the integration. MED e-care will share a spreadsheet with you for each home comparing your residents.

Resident Matching

- Green = Matched The resident matches in both Nourish and MED e-care no action required
- Orange = Partial match Some of the data is different in either Nourish or MED e-care for example the Date of Birth or the NHS/CHI number. Correct the data and ensure that it is the same in both Nourish and MED e-care.
- Red = No match The resident is only appearing in either Nourish or MED e-care, not both. To resolve:
 - Admit resident into Nourish or MED e-care OR
 - Discharge them from Nourish or MED e-care OR
 - If they do appear in Nourish but have a status other than "Onboarding", "Admitted" or "Emergency Admission" we will not be able to automatically match them in MEC. Manual matching will be required.



10.On an agreed date, MED e-care will activate the integration.

Once it is switched on, the data in Nourish will overwrite the date in MED e-care, so it is important that your data in Nourish is accurate and that you have updated any incorrect data identified from the comparison spreadsheet by that date.



IMPORTANT

 Once the integration is switched on, the data in Nourish is dominant and will overwrite the data in MED e-care.

- You must make sure that the resident has an accurate NHS/CHI number for your pharmacy to be able to send medication data for that resident.
- Once the integration is switched on, all new residents must be admitted in Nourish and NOT in MED e-care. The 'New Admission' tab in MED e-care will be switched off to prevent incorrect admissions. Simply admit your resident in Nourish and the data will flow over to MED e-care as a Pre-Admission.
