One-Dimensional Barcoding

MED e-care e-MAR now supports one-dimensional barcode functionality. Barcodes can be used to quickly navigate to a resident's current MAR pass.

How to get the barcode?

Navigate to **e-Reports** >> **ADT** >> **Group** >> **Barcode List (Chart Numbers)** and generate the report. This report will display the barcodes for each resident which you can scan and it will navigate to the current MAR pass screen.

How it works?

- 1. Navigate to Settings >> e-MAR >> Options and select "Bar Code Type: Chart Number".
- 2. Navigate to e-Reports >> ADT >> Group >> Barcode List (Chart Numbers) >> Generate and Print the report.
- 3. Scan the barcode from the printed report using the provided scanner. (for a list of compatible scanners, have your IT department connect with our support department).
- 4. Once you scan the code, the system will navigate to the current MAR pass screen where you can administer the medications for the resident in question.
- 5. If there are no scheduled medications for the resident in the current medication pass, the system displays a warning message.
